## This funding will be used to

- Guarantee that every student will either achieve National Minimum Standard for their year level or have an evidence-based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs.
- Increase the % of prep, year 1 and year 2 students at PM level to 60% by the end of 2020.
- Increase the % of Year 3 and 5 students meeting NMS in writing to 50% by the end of 2020.
- Increase the % of Year 3 and 5 students achieving in the U2B in writing to 25% by 2020.

## Our initiatives include

- Devise a school and cluster moderation process.
- Trialling the P-6 Curriculum model in 2020 for English, Mathematics, Science and HASS.
- Implement additional intensive planning days with cohorts, HOC and Principal.
- Build teachers knowledge of the Australian Curriculum through collaborative planning of units that reference the achievement standards and content descriptors.
- The Australian Curriculum delivered with fidelity and aligned horizontally and vertically across the school.
- Collegial networking, mentoring and coaching opportunities within the cluster and region.
- Continuing the implementation of the teaching reading series.
- Seven Steps in writing implemented in upper year levels.
- Literacy Continua being tracked in all year levels.
- Authentic coaching and feedback process implemented and embedded to develop staff capability and capacity.
